limitless PROJECTS


The semantics of lighting culture can be distilled into one essential concept: the curation of tactile aesthetics opens a portal to the unique, intangible dialogue held by illumination and spatial identity. Luminous choices are a calling card, the gateway to an inimitable feeling that lingers long after we've literally stepped away from a place. Piquing the physical senses is simply the beginning of a more internal impact that lighting design holds for an individual, shaping their immediate perception and defining an overall experience that reaches beyond brick and mortar, leaving behind the simplicity of four walls. Slamp has been at it for years, scribbling, illustrating far outside typical design frontiers in order to step over established boundaries that classify light as a peripheral element, an afterthought to other objects. Objects are palpable and


specifically defined only thanks to the true architect of visual and emotional consciousness: illumination. Whether steeped in opulent abundance, an excess of minimalism, linear innovation, or wafting, limitless poetic verse, the following pages trace how Slamp's endless luminous possibilities stand as the genesis of one's surroundings, the precise foundation for what will be conceived, and what is perceived. The company's take on avant-garde, versatile modular options and stand-alone pieces to be combined at will moves from shapeshifting expansive elements that beg for behance installations to stark architectural sculptures that make up the lustrous bones of a place, when singular or elegantly combined. This book is an invitation, a peek into the potential, the aesthetically unbound, the never-imagined power of light.

Slamp creates suggestive, luminous, and versatile objects using the latest generation of materials, manually moulded into elements that combined together, make up a luxurious landscape.

The use of exclusive, lightweight and resistant technopolymers gives a unique and recognizable touch to every lamp, allowing it to be sculpted into three dimensional shapes, decorations and effects that would be impossible using any other material. Much like any maison dedicated to haute couture, Slamp lamps undergo a precise ritual that transforms a sheet of technopolymer material into an exceptionally decorative, three dimensional shape through cold cutting and handcrafting.

AN ENVELOPING INTRODUCTION

First impressions are eternal, and illuminated service is a calling card for every location.

Light plays a fundamental role in how we perceive a space and its function, even if for a fleeting moment.

Modular systems or individual pieces, uniquely combined, bring **weightless elegance**, ethereal architecture, and unexpected sculptural shapes that frame areas destined to envelop guests.

From an endlessly extended modular ceiling and dominating stand-alone pieces effortlessly grouped, to hauntingly crafted skeletal elements and minimal, linear installations, reception spaces require luminous aesthetics that are essential to a **client's initial perception** and experience.



ABUNDANT PATHWAYS

Making one's way from space to space is taken to new heights with monumental illumination that invites a harmonious flow.

Cascades of almost weightless compositions provoke silent movement, encapsulating stairways without isolating them from surrounding areas; installations become a defining architectural focus in an often overlooked blank space.

Singular suspensions in rhythmic, descending patterns make a structural statement, and flexible modular systems, both in **pre-determined** configurations or **free-standing** options, offer endless possibilities for bespoke, ethereal visuals.




